

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to the <http://www.blessedsacrament.com> and Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to the Congregation of the Blessed Sacrament include <http://www.blessedsacrament.com>, Blessed Sacrament, Saint Ann Shrine and <http://st-ann-shrine.org>, The Blessed Sacrament website is a religious information site. By using the Blessed Sacrament website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

Blessed Sacrament may collect personally identifiable information, such as your name. If you make a donation to or order Blessed Sacrament's products and services, we collect billing and credit card information. This information is used to complete the donation. Blessed Sacrament may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your age, gender and religion. We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by Blessed Sacrament. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Blessed Sacrament website.

Blessed Sacrament encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link from Blessed Sacrament so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. Blessed Sacrament is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the Blessed Sacrament website.

Use of your Personal Information

Blessed Sacrament collects and uses your personal information to operate its website and deliver the services you have requested.

Blessed Sacrament may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from Blessed Sacrament and its affiliates. Blessed Sacrament may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

Blessed Sacrament may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to Blessed Sacrament, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

Blessed Sacrament will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on Blessed Sacrament or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of Blessed Sacrament; and (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of Blessed Sacrament or the public.

Use of Cookies

The Blessed Sacrament website may use “cookies” to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize Blessed Sacrament pages, or register with Blessed Sacrament site or services, a cookie helps Blessed Sacrament to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same Blessed Sacrament website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the Blessed Sacrament features that you customized.
